### Fort Johnson Estates Newsletter - Q1 2025

As you have probably seen, construction is finally underway for our much-anticipated pool renovation project. We have partnered with J. Musselman Construction as the general contractor to perform the work (as well as getting us over the finish line for permitting). Below is a site plan of improvements to the clubhouse grounds and pool area. Although some minor changes have been made, overall, this is the up-to-date plan. We were given an approximate 4-month completion date which would put us right around the end of May/beginning of June. As is typical with any type of construction, we may experience some delays due to weather, permitting/inspections, or other issues along the way, but we have been very pleased with the progress since groundbreaking. Due to the requirement to install a wastewater retainment/treatment system, we will lose the use of space behind the concession stand which will now house the surge tanks and be used for storage of swim team equipment. With the addition of a second entrance behind the clubhouse, we do anticipate being able to use the concession stand now though. In addition to many underground and/or unseen improvements and repairs, we will also be installing a new, upgraded security and entry system that will eliminate key fobs and ease access into the pool area. We will also have a slightly larger pool deck to accommodate our members more easily. There will be new sidewalks along with new concrete pads for basketball, pickleball, and other sports.

We are excited for this project to finally be underway and expect these improvements to be enjoyed by our members and neighbors for many years to come!
